

Take a Windstar Grandkid Fishing

Program – A few selected members of the Windstar Fishing Club have volunteered to take the grandkids of any Windstar resident fishing in the Windstar ponds. This is a community service project.

Equipment & Service – The guide will provide rod and reels, tackle, bait, instruction and careful supervision of the grandkids.

Instruction will be provided (depending on the kid's experience) on how to:

- tie a knot
- bait a hook
- know when a fish bites and how to set the hook
- land the fish
- safely handle the fish and remove the hook
- pose for a photo
- release the fish to prevent injury

Other Information to be provided

- Names of the fish that live in our ponds
- Depth of ponds and other things that live there
- Names of birds, trees and plants around the ponds

Inherent Goals

- Provide a fun, learning experience for both kids and parents
- Ensure the kids are safe, careful of hooks, and watchful of alligators and cars
- Engender a respect for nature

Participant Requirements

- All kids must be accompanied by a parent or grandparent
- Show up at the designated time
- Follow the instructions of their guide
- Release all fish caught
